7. "Thank you's" will be listed.

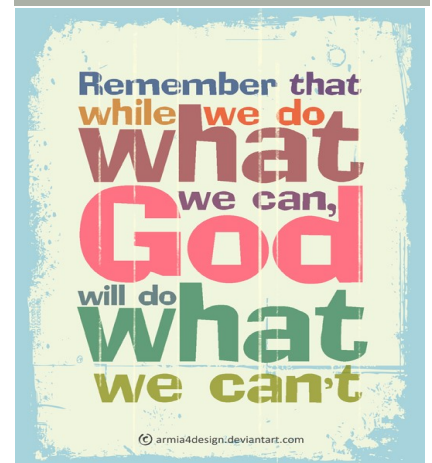
