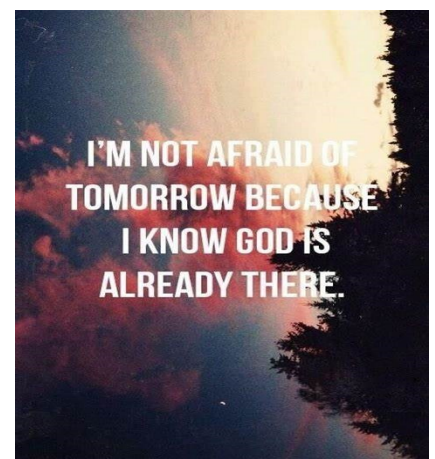

OUR ROOF has been replaced. This is the center section over the offices and classrooms. Since it is a thorough and complete tear-off and replacement, we have discovered some extra needs (that's GOOD news!). The Cooling Tower needs new supports, or eventually it could collapse and fall through the roof. This must be done before its use in the Spring. Also, we need to replace the ceiling tile in two classrooms because of the rotting roof. Please pray about an additional \$10, \$20, \$50 or more gifts at least ONCE to help cover the costs. We can be thankful to Deer Park Roofing for discovering these issues when previous roofers did not look for them. Without this knowledge, this could have been disastrous in the near future. MISSIONS: METANOIA CENTER (LOCKLAND)

The mission of the Metanoia Center is to transform individuals, households, neighborhoods, and communities by sharing the life-giving message of Jesus Christ while providing training and education opportunities to individuals.

Community Health Evangelism, is a proven ministry strategy that seamlessly integrates evangelism, discipleship, and church planting with community health and development. CHE is a wholistic approach, addressing social, mental, physical, emotional and spiritual needs of individuals. Through CHE ministries, people become followers of Jesus, and whole communities are lifted out of cycles of poverty and disease.

The Metanoia Center executes its mission without regard to race, gender, color, ethnicity, disability, religion, national origin, education, or income.

A building, purchased from the Village of Lockland, is located at 115 N. Wayne. It is in the process of being renovated so that effective ministry can take place there. Your donations (including dollars and work labor) are encouraged.

MINISTRY: PROVIDING FOR THE NEEDY

Valley Interfaith Community Resource Center: This ministry located in Lockland has been part of the missions of LCC for many years. Not only are there donations of money, food, and clothing, there are a number of people who have volunteered their services as well.

The first Sunday of each month, we ask that you bring acceptable new or used clothing and non-perishable food items to be given to the Center. You have been very generous in the past, and we want to continue helping "the least of these." (Matthew 25:31-46).

Lockland Food Pantry: Located across from the Lockland Police Department in the village parking lot, a wooden box has been provided by one of LCC's neighbors. We can drop food items there for the immediate needs of Lockland residents. If you'd rather bring them to the church, there is a designated box for your donations.
