“57 Cents” PART TWO

Last month, I printed a story about a poor little girl who was not able to attend Sunday School because there were so many people in the building. Yet, the minister found room for her. A couple of years later, this child died. In her possession was a small purse with 57 cents and a note inside. The note said that the money was to help the church build a bigger building so more children could go to Sunday School.

This church responded. And in the city of Philadelphia stands a building that seats 3300. Beyond that, is Temple University, also built for the purpose of educating thousands of students.

All because of the 57 cents that little girl left.

I believe that Lockland Christian Church can do wonders to help minister to children and adults. We don't need a bigger building, but what we do need is an opportunity to reach out to our community in powerful and effective ways.

This may mean the purchase of Bibles, Bible lessons, or group activity projects.

Beginning in January 2021, LCC will refer to the “Outreach Ministry” (and income) as “Outreach 57.” Of course, the reference is the 57 cents from that little girl. In addition to your regular offerings and other special gifts, would you include another 57 cents, \$5.70, \$57 or more to our “Outreach 57” fund?

We will report each month the purchases made and how those items were or will be distributed. Pray that YOUR 57 will be multiplied for the cause of Christ in our community.

Also, since 2020 will be over, our “2020 Vision” fund will be rolled over to our regular “Repair and Maintenance” fund. The building is always in need of a fix somewhere and your continued giving is very much appreciated.

Since this should not be only about income, let us work toward reaching at least 57 people for Jesus. We still plan to meet on Sunday mornings (unless the Governor urges closing).
